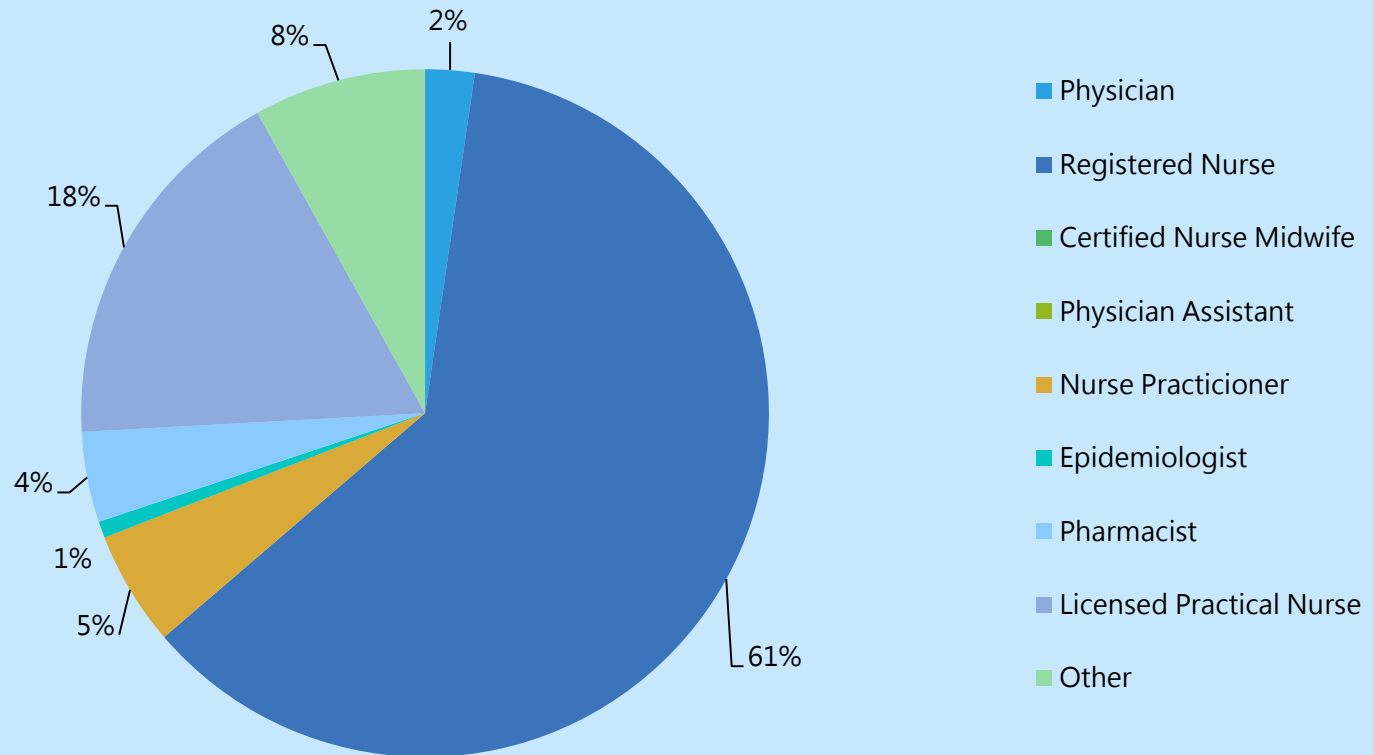

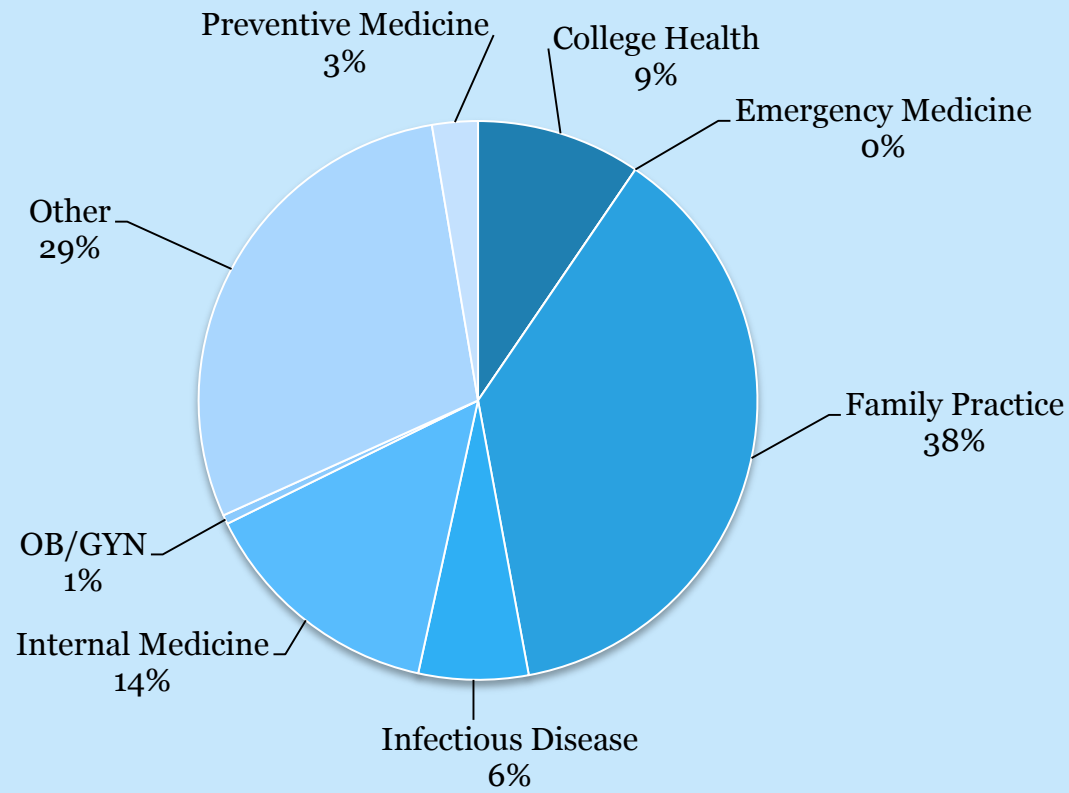
Profession of Attendees

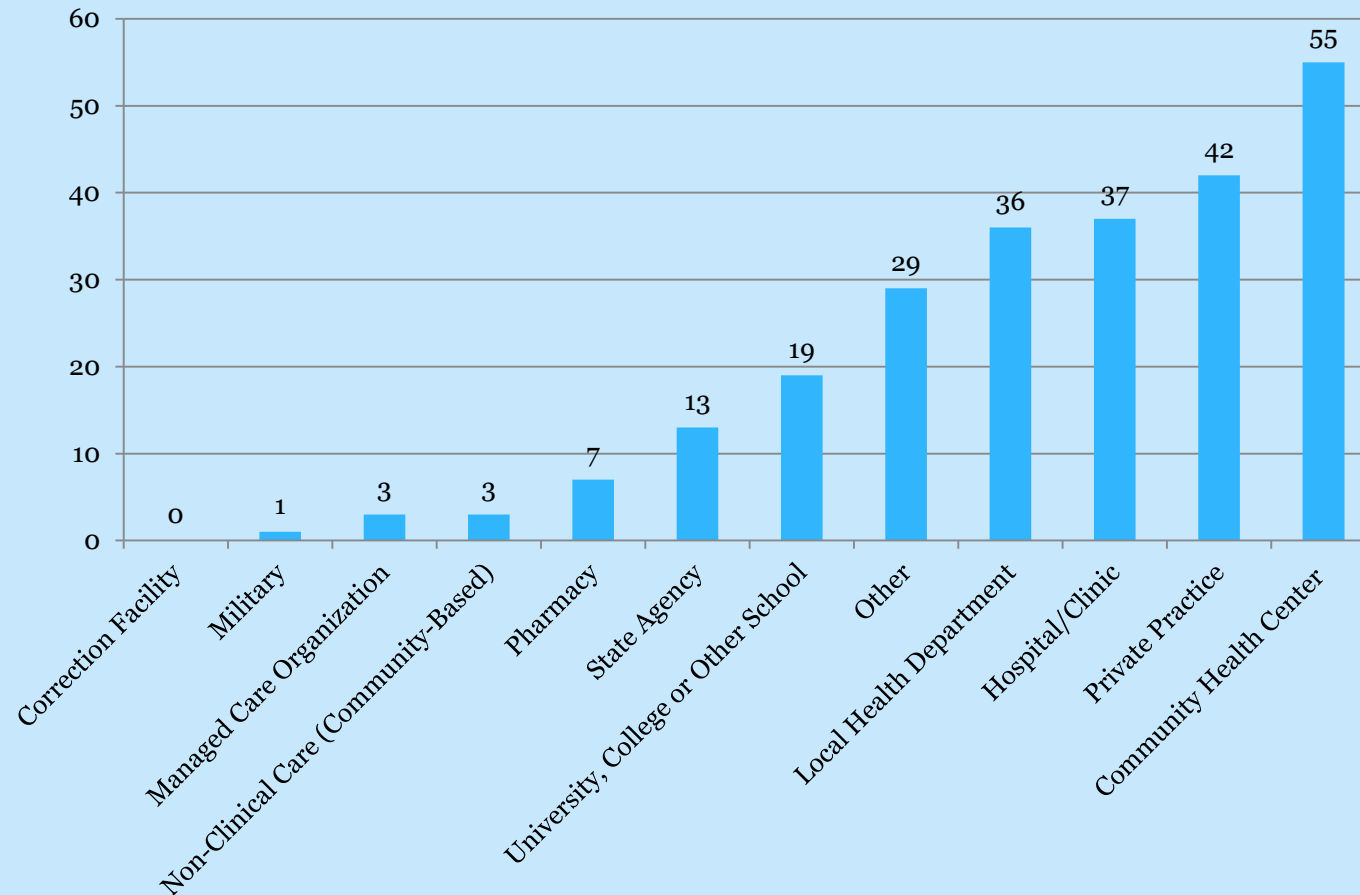
## Speciality of Attendee Employment

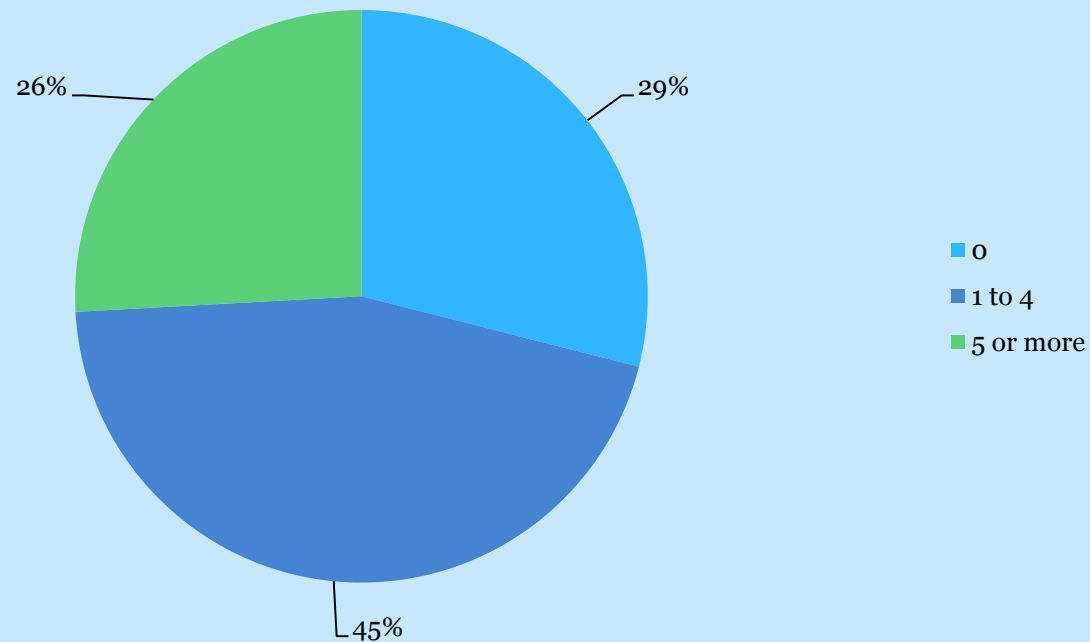
## Attendee from Type of Organization



# MIIS Bi-Directional Data Exchange

**EHR queries MIIS  
for Patient information**

**MIIS responds back with  
patient information  
(demographics & vaccines)  
to your patients record  
within your EHR**



# Benefits of Bi-Directional Data Exchange

1. Reduces the need to log into the MHS application to view patient histories
  2. Patient information goes directly into EHR, no more data entry from one system to another
  3. Provides immunization information that current patient record may be missing
  4. More complete histories helps to prevent over immunizing
  5. Forecast is available offering clinical decision support
  6. Offers better overall patient care
