Just in time for flu season, the Vaccine Finder website has been upgraded and participating providers can now update supply estimates for a more accurate reporting.
- **MedFinder** ([medfinder.org](http://medfinder.org)) is an easy to use website that helps providers and patients save time and resources by helping them find nearby pharmacies with available influenza antiviral drugs. Pharmacies can use the site to enroll and report supply estimates for the medications they carry at each participating location.
