| Covid-19 Vaccine Update | Laurie Courney | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Through collective efforts, 13,406,529 doses have been administered. ● Over 5 million residents fully vaccinated ● 2.5 million booster doses <p><i>Recent Updated Recommendations</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● CDC gave a clinical preference for MRNA over the J&J vaccine. ● CDC also recommended Pfizer booster at 5 months |

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| | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Third primary dose for immunocompromised children ages 5-11 ● CDC recommended boosters for age 12-15 <p><i>Key Points</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Primary series recommended for anyone 5 years or older ● Booster recommended for 12 and older. ● Pfizer only vaccine recommended 12-17, MRNA for 18 and older <p>mRNA over J&J</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Slightly increased risk for TTS in J&J, therefore CDC recommends mRNA over J&J. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If patients choose J&J, they should receive additional counseling <p><i>Language Shift</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stay up to Date With Vaccines <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ While primary series means fully vaccinated, CDC recommends you stay up to date by receiving additional doses. <p><i>Covid-19 Vaccination Gateway Pages Takes You To...</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Vaccines & Immunizations page ● COVID-19 page ● Training module for each vaccine, how to talk to parents/patients about Covid-19 Vaccine, e.t.c. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Second page: Directed at a general audience. ● <i>Question: What about boosters for young healthy people?</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Comes down to risk analysis. Population as a whole, the ACIP team felt strongly that boosters were important in boosting antibody response for stronger safety. |

Please contact your local Sanofi representative or call 1-800-VACCINE to reserve your doses ● In October 2021, the FDA approved FLUCELVAX® QUADRIVALENT – Seqirus’ cell-based influenza vaccine – for use in persons 6 months of age and older at a 0.5ml dose.
