MVCP Mission and Goals

Mission: To increase vaccine confidence throughout Massachusetts so that children and adults within the state will be fully immunized against vaccine-preventable diseases.

□Goals:

- Identify challenges to vaccine confidence in areas of the state with lower than state average immunization rates (school immunization data; engagement with the COVID-19 Vaccine Equity Initiative)
- Address challenges in these areas by building partnerships, and developing resources and training.
- Project outreach includes HCPs, community outreach workers and advocates, and the public.



Project Activities

- Build partnerships which promote vaccine confidence
- Develop provider education (Grand Rounds seminars, conferences, MDPH Immunization Updates, webinars)
- Organize, develop and distribute resources through MVCP newsletter/website and partner communications
- Organize public outreach as appropriate

Vaccine confidence: The trust in the recommended vaccines, the providers who administer them, and the process that leads to vaccine licensure and recommendations.


